**Re: Halachic Approval for Processors for those with AB Implants, models:**  
**Naida CI Q30, Naida CI Q90, Naida CI M90, Sky CI M90,**  
**Naida CI L 90 (Integro), Sky CI L 90 (Integro)**

We hereby confirm that we checked the devices of the above models, and have found that when operating them on a "fixed" state according to the attached instructions\*, the dynamic effects of transfer between the various areas and more are cancelled, and those required to use these devices can do so on Shabbat and holidays.

**This approval is valid for all sub-models of the series listed above, in their various colors.**

- As long as it is a device that works on disposable batteries, one must take care to change the battery prior to the start of Shabbat. If the device is charged, the disposable battery housing must be changed on the eve of Shabbat, with a new battery put into it.
- In devices which possess "Bluetooth" functions, this function must be disconnected before Shabbat or a holiday, or it must be checked that there is no device in the area that could receive from it.
- The device must work for the duration of Shabbat or the holiday, and it must not be operated or disconnected, nor should a change be made to the intensity or programs on Shabbat or the holiday themselves.
